1. Information We Collect

- Name and contact information

- Information submitted through website forms
- Prayer requests or ministry-related requests
- Information provided when requesting assistance or participating in programs
- Information voluntarily provided for donations, events, or other ministry activities

2. Confidentiality

Worldwide Fellowship Ministries will make reasonable efforts to protect personal information provided to the ministry.

Personal information will not be intentionally sold, rented, or disclosed to third parties for their independent marketing purposes.

We will limit access to personal information to individuals who have a legitimate ministry, administrative, operational, legal, or safety-related need to access that information.

3. Exceptions to Confidentiality

Confidentiality cannot be guaranteed in circumstances where disclosure is required or permitted by law, court order, governmental authority, or where disclosure is reasonably necessary to address an emergency, protect an individual from serious harm, prevent unlawful activity, or protect the rights, safety, or property of Worldwide Fellowship Ministries or others.

4. Website Information

Information submitted through our website may be used to respond to inquiries, provide requested services, communicate about ministry activities, administer programs, process donations or registrations, and improve our ministry services.

We do not intentionally collect more personal information than reasonably necessary for these purposes.

5. Third-Party Services

Our website may use third-party services for functions such as website hosting, payment processing, communications, analytics, forms, or other ministry-related services. Information provided through those services may be subject to the privacy policies of the applicable third-party provider.

6. Children's Information
